Tentative Tour Itinerary

DAY 1	Arrival Jodhpur
	On arrival at Jodhpur proceed to hotel. to Jodhpur - Located almost on the edge of the Thar Desert, the city of Jodhpur was founded in 1459 by Rao Jodha, the chief of the Rathore clan of Rajputs and was the capital of the State of Marwar. The city is called the Blue City as it looks completely blue in colour from an aerial view because of its blue walls and blue houses. On arrival visit Mehrangarh Fort - A renowned landmark of Jodhpur, Mehrangarh Fort is one of the largest forts in the city. An ideal vantage point for the panoramic view of Jodhpur, one can trek to the top to see the city spread like a blue ocean at the foot of a hill. Umaid Bhawan Palace - The largest private residence in the world, the Umaid Bhawan Palace was designed by the renowned architecture, Henry Lanchester, and shows a blend of eastern and western architectural influences. The palace is situated on the high ground in the city. Its majestic 105 - foot high cupola is influenced by the Renaissance, while the towers draw inspiration from Rajput tradition. Jaswant Thada - mausoleum, which is more commonly known as the Taj Mahal of Mewar. Hidden amidst lush green trees and perched tenderly on the lakeside. Overnight stay at Jodhpur.

DAY 2	Jodhpur - Jaisalmer
	After breakfast check out from hotel and proceed to Jaisalmer - Situated in the heart of the Thar Desert and close to the India-Pakistan border, Jaisalmer, founded in 1156 by Rawal Jaisal, is carpeted with golden sand and almost every house is built with the yellow Jaisalmer stone thus, making it the 'Golden City'. On arrival check in to hotel. Overnight at Jaisalmer.

DAY 3	Jaisalmer - Sand Dunes
	After breakfast check out from hotel & visit The Jaisal Fort, Jain Temple, Narayan Temple, Patwon Ki Haveli, Nathmalji Ki Haveli, Gadhisar Lake . After lunch proceed to Sand Dunes at Thar Desert. Jaisalmer: Being at the beautiful sand stretches of sand dunes, approx 50 Km far from Jaisalmer. On arrival enjoy Evening Camel Ride in Sand Dunes, Followed by Traditional Dance & Entertainment Performance . Overnight at Tent.

DAY 4	Jaisalmer - Bikaner
	After breakfast check out from hotel and proceed to Bikaner - situated on an elevated ground surrounded by a 7 km long fortified wall with five entrance gates. A magnificent fort built between 1588 and 1593 dominates the city. Enroute visit Karni Mata temple - The temple is world-famous for being home to over 25,000 black rats

	(called <i>kabbas</i>) that are considered sacred and are protected. Later visit Junagarh Fort – one of the few major forts in Rajasthan which is not built on a hilltop, and was built in the reign of Raja Rai Singh, the sixth ruler of Bikaner, who ruled from 1571 to 1611 AD. Lalgarh Palace Museum – The three-st orey complex is coated in red sandstone quarried from the Thar Desert. The complex features magnificent pillars, elaborate fire-places, Italian colonnades and intricate lattice and filigree work. On arrival check in to hotel. Overnight at Bikaner.

DAY 5	Bikaner – Khatu Shyam – Jaipur
	After breakfast check out from hotel and proceed to visit Khatu Shyam Temple . After sightseeing proceed to Jaipur – the capital of Rajasthan is popularly known as the Pink City. With broad avenues and spacious gardens, the city is steeped in history and culture. Here the past comes alive in magnificent forts and palaces, blushed pink, where once lived the maharajas. On arrival check in to hotel. Overnight at Jaipur.

DAY 6	Jaipur Local Sightseeing
	After breakfast proceed to visit City Palace – The Royal Palace was built in the 18th century by the Maharaja Jai Singh II, who was the Rajput king of Amber. Some of the special features such as magnificent pillars, lattice or jali work, carved marble interiors and inlaid ornamentations make the palace beautiful in appearance and a treat to watch for the visitors. Jantar Mantar – an astronomical observatory used to measure the distances and positions of celestial objects. India has a total of five such observatories, the largest of which is in Jaipur. The Jantar Mantar was constructed by Maharaja Sawai Jai Singh II who from a very young age was fascinated by the movement of the celestial objects. Visit Amer Fort & Palace – Built by Raja Man Singh, is a scenic marvel. It stands on top of an easily scalable mountain, which is situated right next to the beautiful Maota Lake. The fort’s majestic appearance and its geographical advantages make it a special place to visit. Overnight stay at Jaipur.

DAY 7	Jaipur – Pushkar
	After breakfast check out from hotel & proceed to Pushkar. On arrival visit Pushkar Brahma Temple – dates from the 14th century. The colorful structure is made of marble and stone. Pushkar Lake – considered one of the holiest lakes in India. Overnight at Pushkar.

DAY 8	Pushkar – Chittodgarh – Udaipur
	After breakfast check out from hotel & proceed to Chittorgarh , a land of valour, sacrifice, glory, pride, and romance. On arrival, visit Chittorgarh Fort – Rana Kumbha Palace, Vijay Stambh and Padmini Mahal . After lunch leave for Udaipur, A city that defines the royal essence of the great Thar Desert, a city that redefines love

	and romance, a city that echoes imperial lifestyle of the past. On arrival check in at hotel. Overnight at Udaipur.

DAY 9	Udaipur Local
	After breakfast, proceed for local sightseeing in Udaipur. Visit Maharana Pratap Smarak Memorial which is situated atop Moti Magri or Pearl Hill on the banks of Fateh Sagar Lake . City Palace is an example of the splendour that the rulers of Mewar enjoyed centuries ago, Saheliyon ki Bari is one the most beautiful gardens in Rajasthan. Jagdish Temple is one of the famous temples of Udaipur. In the evening, enjoy the Cultural Show. Overnight at Udaipur

DAY 10	Udaipur - Mount Abu
	After breakfast check out from hotel & proceed to Mount Abu , the only hill station of Rajasthan, its cool atmosphere and lush green surroundings make it a major tourist spot within the state. On arrival visit Bramha Kumari Ashram , Dilwara Temple is one of the finest Jain temple , known world over for its extraordinary architecture and marvelous marble stone carvings. Evening enjoy Boating at Nakki Lake . Overnight at Mount Abu.

DAY 11	Mount Abu - Abu Road Departure
	After breakfast check out from the hotel and proceed to Abu Road railway station for your return journey. The tour concluded with sweet memories.
