OVERVIEW

Sri Lanka tourism highlights include Colombo, the vibrant capital with modern and colonial charm; Sigiriya, home to the ancient rock fortress; Kandy, a cultural hub with the Temple of the Tooth; Nuwara Eliya, known for tea plantations; and Bentota, a beach paradise perfect for relaxation and water sports.

ITINERARY

Day 01: Mumbai – Colombo Flight

Welcome to Colombo – Capital city of Sri Lanka. On arrival we will be transferred to Colombo hotel. Overnight stay at Colombo Hotel
(Dinner)

Day 02: Colombo – Golden Cave Temple – Dambulla (185 Km, 4 Hours 30 Minutes)

Enjoy breakfast at your hotel in Colombo. Depart for Dambulla, a journey of approximately 4 hours by road. After lunch check into your hotel in Dambulla. Explore Dambulla Cave and Golden Temple - It is the largest and best-preserved cave temple compound in Sri Lanka. There are above 80 chronicle caves around this location. The most prominent allures are advanced over 5 caves, which contain statues and paintings. These paintings and statues are depicted to Lord Buddha and his life. There are a total of 153 Buddha statues, 3 statues of Sri Lankan kings and 4 statues of gods and goddesses. Head to Sigiriya for a photo stop at the iconic Sigiriya Rock Fortress. Capture the stunning view of the rock from a distance. Enjoy dinner at your hotel & spend the night at your hotel in Dambulla.

Day 03: Dambulla – Matale Spice Garden - Kandy City (75 Km- 3 Hours)

Start your day with breakfast at the hotel in Dambulla. Head to Matale and visit a spice garden to learn about various spices grown in Sri Lanka. Enjoy a guided tour and perhaps purchase some local spices. Have lunch on your way to Kandy. Visit the Temple of the Tooth Relic: Explore the Sacred Temple of the Tooth Relic (Sri Dalada Maligawa), a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Take in the spiritual and historical significance of the temple. Attend the Kandy Cultural Show in the evening, showcasing traditional dance and music performances. Enjoy dinner at your hotel & spend the night at your hotel in Kandy.

Day 04: Kandy – Pinnawala – Kandy city tour

After breakfast we will be transferred to Pinnawala Elephant Orphanage - The orphanage was originally founded to provide care and protection to the many orphaned elephants found in the jungles of Sri Lanka. Pinnawala has the largest herd of captive elephants in the world. Tourists can observe the bathing elephants from the broad riverbank as the herd interacts socially, bathing and playing. Visitors to the park can view the care and daily routine of the elephants, such as bathing in the Ma Oya (River). Enjoy lunch in the Pinnawala area. Visit the Kandy View Point for panoramic views of the city. Visit Gems Gallery, Take a leisurely walk around Kandy Lake. Explore the Kandy city center and its vibrant markets. Enjoy dinner at your hotel & spend the night at your hotel in Kandy.

Day 05: Kandy – Nuwara Eliya local sightseeing (96 Km - 3 Hours)

After breakfast we proceed to Nuwara Eliya, Enroute visit Tea Factory, Arrival Nuwara Eliya checks in to your hotel. After Lunch we visit to Nuwara Eliya Sita Amman Temple – According to legends; this is the place where Sita Mata spent her days in the prison of Ravana (Ashoka Vatika). Later we visit to Hakgala Botanical Garden - Hakgala Botanical Garden is situated on the Nuwara Eliya-Badulla main road, 16 km from Nuwara Eliya and extends for about 28 hectares. The garden has a cool temperate climate because of altitude is 5,400 feet above sea level. In the evening free time for Gregory Lake - Gregory Lake is located about 1 km from the town, in the heart of Nuwara Eliya, and is an artificial lake built by the then Governor Gregory in 1874. The entire lake covers an area of about 91 hectares and is obtained by introducing the water of the Nanuwarya River through a tunnel, with beautiful scenery.

Day 06: Nuwara Eliya - Ramboda Waterfall – Bentota (210km - 5 Hours 30 Minutes)

After breakfast proceeds to Bentota, Enroute we visit to Anjaneyar (Hanuman) Temple of Ramayana Trail in Ramboda, Ramboda Fall. Lunch in route, Evening Arrival Bentota, check in at hotel, Enjoy Bentota Beach & Sunset. Dinner & overnight stay at Bentota.

Day 07: Madu River Boating, Turtle Hatchery, Bentota Beach

After breakfast we will enjoy a boat ride along the Madhu River. It is a scenic tour relaxing and interesting while passing many islets forested with mangroves and experience the natural rhythms as well. If you are looking for more exclusive experience visit the turtle hatchery too. The Turtle Hatchery is the prime turtle nesting site which was opened by the Wildlife Protection Society in 1981. Visitors can see huge tanks filled with newly born turtle hatchlings. After being fed, the baby turtles are taken to the sea and released when they are 2-4 days old, usually during the safer hours of darkness. After lunch, engage in a range of thrilling water sports activities such as jet skiing, banana boat riding, etc. (own exp). Overnight stay at Bentota.

(Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Day 08: Hotel Check-out – Colombo City Tour

After breakfast hotel check-out & proceed to Colombo city, Enroute Hindu temple, Colombo Lotus Tower, Independence Square, Parliament Building (outside from Bus) & shopping center. After lunch drop to airport. Tour concludes. Let's Stay in Touch and Meet Again on another Memorable Destination. See You Soon.
